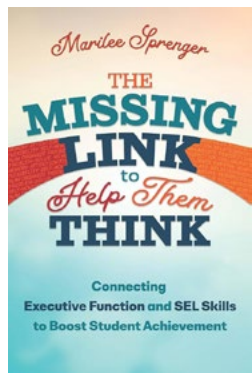

The Zoom meeting will take place at 5:30 PM Mountain Time / 6:30 PM Central Time.

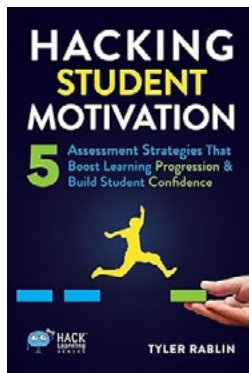
